Here are questions and notes to pray about. Note that the 'soon' and 'later' items are not things we need to decide at this point – and time-frames may change – but are listed to give a sense of what might be ahead for us to decide – and for us to be thinking and praying about now. There are many needs listed here and we invite you to pray about how these needs might be met.



BUDGET. Several strategies have been put in place to realise funds and reduce costs. The sale of Norman Park and the installation of solar at the Carina Ministry Centre are the two best examples. The Board and staff actively manage this issue. Please review the budget material on the following pages.

SPRINGFIELD MINISTRY SPACE. Our Springfield Campus has settled into their new venue. Benefits are being seen in particularly our Kids ministry as, along with new team members, the ministry lifts and the fun increases as kids hear about Jesus.

CROSS CULTURE CONNECT. 2017 has seen increased communication and engagement with our Cross Culture Connect Partners. Chats on the phone and Skype have helped us to understand the challenges they face, the opportunities before them and then to pray for their exact needs. It is from these chats that we are better able to encourage our Growth Groups to join with one of our Cross Culture Partners and tell people about Jesus.

MINISTRY AT CREEK ROAD. We praise God daily for the amazing ministry, we as a church, are able to do for Jesus. This fulfils our Vision to be a church that Reaches the City and Reaches the World for him. Commitment to teaching God's word and to then actively live out God's word in community is bearing fruit in newcomers, long-term members, little kids, older folk and everyone in between. The weekly prayer notes provides a summary of God's provision to us.

JOHN WARLOW PARTNERSHIP. The Christian Wholeness Framework is well known to Creek Road. Loving and caring Church Gets Wrong, But Jesus Makes Right' series. As we think through who we are as a church showing Jesus' love, we're keen to make a real difference in such issues as: Slavery, Fostering/Adoption, Mental Health, Refugees, Aged Care, and Faith at Work. The Sally Irwin visit from The Freedom Hub offers an opportunity for us to get involved with making a real difference on the issue of slavery. **TRAINING PIPELINE:** We are looking ahead to 2018 with a renewed focus on encouraging people to consider training through such options as Gap year, Leadership Development Program, Ministry Traineeships as well as study at Theological College. We especially want to develop training resources for use in mentoring contexts.

SOON Q4 2017-Q1 2018

CARINA CAMPUS PASTOR. After much prayer and discussion, we have approached a minister and they are currently considering this ministry opportunity. Discussions are in the very early phases, please pray for all involved. We will share information as it becomes available.

CARINA FACILITY UPGRADE. We are wanting to explore options for upgrading the outdoor area of our Carina facility. We want to make it an excellent area for everyone from adults to kids. In the future there is still the possibility of building something significant on the vacant block, but for now we want to do a more modest outdoor improvement that might tie in with anything we do in the future. We are very much wanting to consult with everyone from the Carina campus about their thoughts on what would be of benefit for everyone. As with the consultation for the change from four services to two, Chris Pine and Andrea Pryde will be available after services at Carina to talk this through. This consultation will start Sunday 16 July 2017.

CROSS CULTURE CONNECT TEAM. Big picture planning is underway to establish a church wide approach to helping international people to connect, grow and serve at Creek Road. The establishment of a Cross Culture Connect Team is a key focus in the coming months.

for our people, that is Pastoral Care, is built around this framework. The author, Dr John Warlow will be working with staff in the coming six months, to train and equip. It is planned that this training will be extended to leaders across the church, particularly Growth Group Leaders, Kids and Youth Growth Group Leaders and Ministry Team Leaders in 2018.

FREEDOM HUB. Slavery is a reality in Australia. Precious people trapped by evil. Partnership between Creek Road and Sally & Gavin Irwin and the Freedom Hub Café continues to grow. Freedom Hub have commenced detailed planning for a venue in Brisbane that will give people fleeing slavery safety and a future. Creek Road is playing its part in this ministry opportunity.

SOUTH BANK MEETING SPACE. Queensland Theatre is going to be renovating the space that our South Bank Campus currently rents each week. Alternate venues are being sought now. Potential exists to partner with the Freedom Hub Café to work from the same venue. This partnership would bring long-term ministry and financial benefits.

CHURCH2CHURCH

For many years, Creek Road has sought to love and care for churches who are ministering across Australia and the world through the sharing of resources and expertise.

The benefit that partner churches have reported, the desire of more and more churches to join and the increasing impost on Creek Road to manage this expanding network has prompted the Board to move towards establishing Church2Church.

So put simply Church2Church will provide the support required to grow the partner church ministries at Creek Road, which will

- Enhance the ministries of both partner churches and Creek Road campuses;
- Create avenues for participating churches to contribute;
- Provide pastors with the mentoring that's desperately needed.

EXPERIENCED MENTORS

Dave and Kathy Thurston are the proposed candidates for the positions of Ministry Mentors within Church2Church. Dave and Kathy are currently ministering at Abbotsford Presbyterian

Church Sydney. They have ministered in the Presbyterian Church in NSW for over thirty years in the local church setting as well as through a long-term ministry in mentoring staff in many different ministry settings. It is planned that they will commence work with Church2Church in early 2018. Dave will be attending the July Ministry Dinner to speak about how he and Kathy see this role contributing to our partner churches and Creek Road.

Significant achievements within our existing partner church network over the past three

months demonstrate the forward momentum for Church2Church.

- The ministry in Adelaide has taken a significant step forward with identification of a Senior Pastor candidate in David Gunning, together with plans for a multisite ministry across Adelaide, resourced by Church2Church,
- ii. Matt Oates, Senior Pastor at Epping Presbyterian Church (one of our Partner Churches), is the Assembly nominee for a senior role in the Presbyterian Church of NSW, responsible for resourcing churches. Matt is anticipating that Church2Church will play a significant role in supporting churches across New South Wales,
- iii. Significant funding (\$120K) has been received from Christian business people who have identified Church2Church as the way forward in ministry provision, and we are in discussions with other such people,
- iv. Representatives of the Presbyterian Church of Queensland and the Presbyterian Church of Australia are supportive of the establishment of Church2Church and funding discussions are progressing well.

STRENGTHS OF CHURCH2CHURCH INCLUDE:-

- Combining both church resources and mentoring to support Church leadership growth;
- Partner network already over 25 churches;
- Strongly Evangelical and Presbyterian based;
- Suited to small to medium sized churches in both regional and urban areas.

NEXT STEPS

The Church2Church entity will be registered with the Australian Charities and Not-forprofits Commission (ACNC). The Steering Committee will commence detailed planning for the operational implementation of the Church2Church. We also will continue engaging with various church organisations and potential supporters to share the growth plans for this ministry.
